



History of the Internet: Commercialization


- 1990's: Emergence of Internet Service Providers (ISPs)
- 1995: Complete commercialization (no restriction to carry commercial traffic)
 - public e-mail (e.g., AOL: 1991)
 - instant messaging (~1997)
 - VoIP (Voice over Internet Protocol) (e.g., Skype: 2003)
 - WWW (1993)



The percentage of two-way telecommunication carried on the Internet




The number of computers on the Internet (2021: over 4 billion)




Number of internet users worldwide from 2005 to 2025 (in millions)



History of World Wide Web: Precursors

- 1990: Archie search engine
 - Developed at McGill to search FTP sites (~200 sites)
- 1991: WAIS (Wide Area Information Server)
- 1991: Gopher (search documents)

History of WWW


- 1990: Sir Tim Berners-Lee creates the first web browser, **WorldWideWeb**
- URI (<http://www.ietf.org/rfc/rfc2396.txt>)
- HTML
- HTTP
- 1993: Mosaic browser is released



History of WWW: Search Engines

- 1993: Excite 
- 1994: Yahoo; WebCrawler (first full-text search engine), Lycos  
- 1995: Infoseek, AltaVista (natural language inquiries) 
- 1997: Google
